

## HARVEST FOODBANK COLLECTION

Each month St Paul's Church has a foodbank collection in support of Living Well Bromley (based at Holy Trinity, Lennard Road) or Christians Against Poverty (Penge). This helps both organisations to provide essential food supplies free of charge. If you would like to join with us in making a donation at this Harvest time the following items are needed for people who are homeless and those in financial need. It is particularly helpful if tins have ring pulls.

- tins of meat, fish, vegetables, tomatoes, fruit, baked beans, spaghetti, soup
- long life cartons of milk
- small packets of rice, pasta or mashed potato
- small jars of coffee, sugar, tea
- biscuits, cereal and snack bars
- packets of soup
  
- toilet rolls
- shower gel
- deodorant

Please take a look at the 'for one week only', 'buy one get one free', 'buy 2 for the price of 1' special offers in the shops and supermarkets, particularly if it is for food you usually buy, and donate the 'extra' food to the foodbank.
